

ORDINANCE NO. 192-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, SECTION 10 "CONDUCT IN PUBLIC PARKS AND BEACHES" OF THE "POLICE CODE" OF THE CLEARLAKE MUNICIPAL CODE

The City Council of the City of Clearlake does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT

The purpose of this Ordinance is to set forth rules and regulations for the possession of alcoholic beverages in city parks and beaches.

SECTION 2. Section 5-10.3(j) of the Clearlake Municipal Code is hereby added as follows:

5-10.3(j) No person shall possess or consume in any Park or in any Park parking area any alcoholic beverage. Alcoholic beverage includes alcohol, spirits, liquor, wine, beer and any liquid or solid containing alcohol by volume in which is fit for beverage purposes either alone or when diluted, mixed or combined with other substances.

1. Exceptions; (a) Special Event permit; consumption and possession of alcohol may be allowed in conjunction with a community special event, subject to obtaining a special event permit from the City of Clearlake pursuant to section 5 – 19 of the Clearlake Municipal Code.

SECTION 3: CONFLICTS AND SEVERABILITY

All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflicts and no further.

If any section, subsection, clause, sentence, work or phrase of this title is for any reason held to be invalid and/or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the title. The City Council declares that it would have passed and adopted this ordinance and each of the provisions thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more such provisions be declared invalid and/or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE:

The effective date of this Ordinance is thirty (30) days after its adoption by the City Council.

SECTION 5: PUBLICATION:

Within fifteen (15) days after passage of this Ordinance, shall be published, including the names of the city councilmembers voting for and against its passage, at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated within the city of Clearlake.
